## About Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJ & E)

- ▶ Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJ & E) is the nodal department of Government of India for the overall policy, planning and coordination of programmes/ schemes for the development and welfare of marginalised and vulnerable groups.
- ▶ Under MoSJ & E there are many schemes designed and implemented through various Central/ State Govt. Departments/ other implementing agencies which need to be monitored and evaluated from time to time.
- ▶ MoSJ&E proposes to recruit young professionals for the post of State Co-ordinators for its PMU.

## About National Testing Agency

- ▶ National Testing Agency(NTA) was set up by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- ▶ It is an independent, autonomous and self-sustaining organisation.
- ▶ It is a Premier Testing Agency
- ▶ It conducts efficient, transparent and international standards tests in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission to premier higher educational institutions.
- ▶ **National Testing Agency (NTA)** has been entrusted with the responsibility to conduct the recruitment Exam of PMUs for MoSJ & E.

## About the Recruitment Exam of State Co-ordinators for Project Monitoring Unit(PMU) of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJ & E)

- ▶ National Testing Agency under the Ministry of Education will conduct Recruitment Exam of State Co-ordinators for Project Monitoring Unit(PMU) of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJ & E) is **an internet based (Online) mode examination.**
- ▶ **The purpose of the webinar is to give an overview about the online exam to the candidates.**

## Mode of Delivery of the Exam

- ▶ Candidates are **not** required to visit any exam centre for taking the exam.
- ▶ Candidates will be required to appear in the Exam on **Laptops/Desktops/PCs only**.
- ▶ You will **not** be able to appear in the exam on Mobile Phones.
- ▶ You will have to make your own arrangements for Laptop/Desktops/PCs
- ▶ You should ensure that the Laptop is **fully charged** and has **stable internet connectivity during the exam**.

# Exam Format

- ▶ Duration of the exam is **60 minutes**.
- ▶ The paper comprises 2 Questions which are descriptive. Candidates will be required to write essays on the given topics, in not more than 500 words each.
- ▶ The test is delivered in English Only.
- ▶ Candidates will be required to login to the specified site and type their descriptive answers on their Desktops/Personal Computers or laptops from their location.

## Recruitment Exam of State Co-ordinators for Project Monitoring Unit(PMU) of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MSJ & E)

- ▶ Candidates should **login atleast 30 minutes before** the start of the exam.
- ▶ You cannot login after the commencement of the exam.
- ▶ You can submit and leave the exam 45 minutes after the commencement of the exam.
- ▶ **SUBMIT** button will be activated only 45 minutes after commencement of the exam.



# Admit Cards

- ▶ Admit Cards were hosted on NTA website on 5 September.
- ▶ Candidates can download and print their admit cards at <https://nisd.nta.ac.in/> using their Registration Number.
- ▶ Candidates will not be allowed to take the exam without Admit Card and a valid ID proof

# Admit Cards

Admit Card contains the following important details, amongst others:

- Date and time of exam
- Login Time
- Login ID
- Password
- Hardware and Software Specifications for the Laptops/Desktop/PCs
- Specific Do's and Don'ts

## Do's

- ▶ Candidates can keep only Admit Card, ID proof and water in a transparent water bottle
- ▶ Candidate should sit facing the screen throughout the exam
- ▶ Sit in a well-lit room
- ▶ Download the Secured Exam Browser (SEB) app from the website mentioned in the Admit Card
- ▶ Keep a check on the CHAT window for any communication from the Proctor

## During the exam

- ▶ Do not keep sheets of paper for rough work etc.
- ▶ Do not move from your seat. You cannot take Bio Breaks.
- ▶ Do not keep mobile phones and other electronic devices
- ▶ There should not be anyone else in the room other than you
- ▶ Do not talk to anyone
- ▶ Do not access any other site
- ▶ Do not login from multiple devices
- ▶ Do not lip-sync or read aloud
- ▶ Do not cover your face
- ▶ Do not play music etc.
- ▶ Do not eat or drink other than water kept in a transparent water bottle
- ▶ Do not toggle between applications
- ▶ Do not wear sunglasses/headphones

# Mock Test

- ▶ Mock Test will be held on **13 September 2023** in the online mode.
- ▶ Candidates must take the mock test on Desktop/Laptop/PCs
- ▶ Mock test window will be open from **10.00 am to 05.00 pm** on **13 September**.
- ▶ Candidates will be required to download the **Secured Exam Browser** from the site which will be made available on 11 September 2023.
- ▶ Candidates can log in using the Login ID and Password indicated on the Admit Card.

# Mock Test

- ▶ Candidates must appear in the Mock Test on 13 September 2023 without fail.
- ▶ Mock Test will be in English for all candidates.
- ▶ Duration of Mock Test is 60 minutes.
- ▶ A candidate can submit the Mock Test, after 45 minutes from the commencement of the Test. He/she cannot submit the mock test before that time.
